## 3<sup>rd</sup> Party Document Archive Integration at

Maidstone Council, a medium sized district council in Kent, employed the services of Highpoint to migrate from Agresso 5.4 to 5.5.3. The council have been using Agresso since version 5.2, first implemented in the late '90s. They use the typical range of modules including Core Financials, Procurement and Sales Order Processing.



In addition the council employ a 3<sup>rd</sup> Party document management system, Information@Work (I@W) from Northgate, which was integrated with Agresso in version 5.4 for the purpose of holding images of Supplier and Purchase Order Invoices.

### The Brief

As a preferred Upgrade Partner of Unit4, Highpoint already had experience of upgrading organisations from Agresso 5.4 to 5.5.3. In addition Highpoint are the only organisation (including Unit4 themselves) to have experience of migrating Customers from I@W on 5.4 to I@W on 5.5.3.

Highpoint were seen as the obvious choice to carry out the upgrade at Maidstone Council.

### Our Contribution

Dan Farmer of Highpoint had previously worked closely with the Unit4 development team in order to develop a new integrated solution between I@W and Agresso in 5.5.3.

It was essential that any development would be integrated with the standard **ABW Document Archive** system ensuring that the final solution would provide a seamless integration into I@W when compared to the basic and relatively insecure solution in Agresso 5.4.
